Targeted legislation Draft DMA, DSA, GDPR and privacy regulations, regulation of

platforms & social networks, Data Governance Act, Data Act, regulation of AI, Big Data, sectoral regulation such as autonomous

vehicles, all regulation having an impact on data

Suggested topics Participants will be encouraged to suggest topics for discussion and

possibly introduce those to the working group. Co-chairs will fix the
